

"Science"


= the whole system of values & ideas on which all scientific thinking is based (and the discoveries that result)

Reason from experience

Claim nothing more than the evidence proves

Accept you could be wrong

Allow the evidence to change your mind

Scientific Methods

Any reliable process of (1) forming a hypothesis and (2) testing that hypothesis against the evidence (formally or informally).

Scientific Principles

Open publication of discoveries
Free speech and unhindered debate
Deductive logic and empirical evidence
Confirming or refuting hypotheses

6. Therefore, there is no scientific reason to believe in god.


...But...

7. There is enough (informal) scientific reason to believe everything is (probably) explained instead by mindless natural causes.

Curiosity (as long as our dogma is off limits)

The Universal Gravitational Constant

Natural Units = Smallest meaningful length of space & time physically possible in the known universe

Planck's Constant = h = 1 (in metric units h equals 6.626 x 10^{-34} j-s)




Fine Structure Constant = α = 7.297 x 10⁻³

 α entails what chemistry exists, what chemistry exists entails whether life exists, but how will α change if c, h, and G change? We don't know.


Shocking Claim No. 1

When science answers religious questions, it doesn't find God, only Nature.





Therefore, the only religion that can keep God in it is a religion that conflicts with scientific findings, methods or values.




Shocking Claim No. 2

Science can also tell us what's right and wrong?

No way, dude!

You can't get an "ought" from an "is"!



What if you're a scientist testing the effects of oil deprivation on your car's engine?

What if oiling your engine will turn it into a fireball of unholy death?

"You ought to change the oil in your car" is true if (and only if):

- (1) You want your car to continue working
- (2) If you don't change its oil, you car will soon stop working (and, of course, if nothing bad will happen if you add the oil)

If it is the case that you want your car to work, and it is the case that it won't work if you don't change the oil (and nothing bad will happen if you do), then you ought to change the oil.

Medicine: How you ought to act to save or fix a patient.

Engineering: How you ought to act to build sturdy bridges or not melt your astronauts

how to Discover Morals

- 1. What desire does obeying morals satisfy in us?
- 2. What behaviors will actually have that result?

The moral thing to do is what you "ought" to do more than anything else.

If the moral thing to do is what we ought to do more than anything else, then the moral thing to do is what gives us what we want more than anything else.

Christian Answers to "Uhy Be Moral?"

If we knew what was good for us, then...

We'd want to go to heaven more than anything else.

We'd want avoid hell more than anything else.

We'd want God's loving presence more than anything else.

Ancient Scientific Morality

What's the right thing to do?

To answer that, just scientifically discover two facts:

What's the Nature of Man?

What's the Nature of the Universe?

Galen's Path to Morality...

- 1. Live a life of honest self-reflection and study
- 2. Have a good grasp of logic and reason
- 3. Get a good education in the relevant arts and sciences

To know right from wrong, you have to know how the world really works, and what human needs really are.

Lactantius Tells Galen to Go Such It...

Logic is too hard, education is waste of time, and self-understanding is vain. Only God helps.

Give him any moral reprobate, Lactantius says, and "with a very few words of God I will render him as gentle as a sheep."

To know right from wrong, you have to know how the world really works, and what human needs really are.

(You also have to know how to think clearly)

How do we know which heaven and hell exist? How do we know who really goes there? How do we know what actually gets us there?

You ought to obey the Bible, because if you do you'll go to heaven, and if you don't you'll go to hell.

But for this "ought" to be true, two facts must be true...

1. Obeying the Bible must actually result in your going to heaven, and not obeying the Bible must actually result in your going to hell.


2. You must actually want to go to heaven and not to hell.





Science and scientific thinking are always the better way to discover the actual facts.


Therefore, scientific morality will be better than any other morality.



Even Christians agree that moral facts follow from what we really want most, and what will really happen when we act one way rather than another.



Therefore, moral facts follow from the actual facts about human nature and the universe.

Therefore, if science discovers the actual facts about human nature and the universe, then science will have discovered moral facts.

If God created everything, then God is responsible for all the facts of human nature and the universe.

If God is responsible for all the facts of human nature and the universe, and God only does what he wants, then all these facts are what God wants them to be.

Therefore, if science discovers moral facts by discovering the facts of human nature and the universe, then science will have discovered the moral facts God wants us to find.

Therefore, if God exists, then moral science can only discover God's will; it cannot discover any morals contrary to God's will.

Shocking Claim No. 2

We can only discover what's morally true by discovering what we really most want from life, and how we can really achieve that with our actions and choices.

(Hint: We want to be happy)

The Bible can't tell us these things. Because...

- It's ignorant of the facts of the universe
- It's ignorant of the facts of human nature
- It's ignorant of how societies, economies work
- It fails to recommend the only reliable methods: science, education and self-reflection.
